

WHAT IS TOTUS TUUS?

Totus Tuus is a parish-based Catholic summer camp and young adult missionary program in the Archdiocese of Toronto, dedicated to proclaiming the Gospel and forming young people in the Catholic faith. Through week-long camps for Grades 1-12, missionaries seek to foster evangelization, faith formation, and leadership development in the next generation of disciples.



MISSION OF TOTUS TUUS

The mission of Totus Tuus is to **inspire in young people a true longing for holiness, a deep desire for daily conversion, and an openness to their vocation** by challenging them to give themselves entirely to Christ through Mary. This is accomplished by strengthening their prayer lives in imitation of Mary's faithfulness.

VOCATIONAL IMPACT

Totus Tuus forms young adults as joyful, discerning missionary disciples through daily prayer, the sacraments, community life, and evangelization. Missionaries grow in holiness and vocational clarity, with many alumni pursuing priesthood, religious life, holy marriages, and leadership in lay ministry, carrying the missionary spirit throughout the Church.



DAY PROGRAM

(Grades 1-6)

Monday to Friday, 8:45 AM - 2:30 PM

- For children entering Grades 1-6
- 3 interactive sessions each day that bring the Catholic faith to life
- Daily Mass with music and learning the parts of the Mass
- Games, songs, skits, icebreakers, recess & prayer – every day!
- Helps children grow in confidence in their Catholic faith
- Shows kids that following Jesus is exciting, meaningful, and doable
- Rooted in prayer and the Sacraments for a faith that lasts



EVENING PROGRAM

(Grades 7-12)

- Engaging talks, small group discussions, and real conversations
- Time for prayer, quiet reflection, and fellowship
- A welcoming environment where every young person is respected and heard
- Encourages youth to ask questions, grow deeper, and own their faith
- This year's focus: The 10 Commandments & the Sorrowful Mysteries
- Discover how Christ's sacrifice calls us to live with purpose, love, and hope
